- Start Strong
- Chronic Absences
- Early Absences Lead to Attendance Issues in Later Grades
- Chronic Absence = Missing two or more days per month
- Third Grade Reading Level
- Dropout Indicator
- Excused Absences Hurt Too
- At Risk Students are at Risk for Absence
- Every Minute Matters


