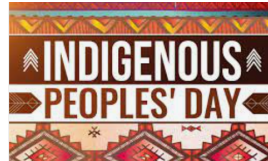

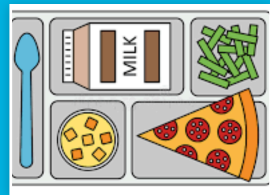

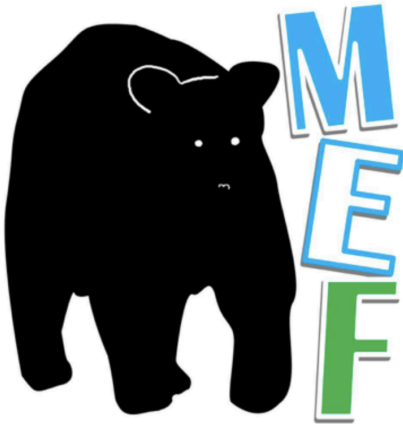
Things to think about.....
