Subject: Recommendation for Make-Up Days Due to School Closures
Date: January 2, 2024

I am writing to recommend proposed make-up days for 2 out of the 3 school days when we were closed due to the weather event during the week of December 18th.

As outlined in the academic calendar, schools must be in session for 175 instructional days. Due to the storm days on Tuesday, December 19 and December 20, I propose we make up these 2 missed days on the following dates:

- Wednesday, January $24^{\text {th }}$, Early Release Day becomes a Full Student Day
- Tuesday, May $8^{\text {th }}$, Early Release Day becomes a Full Student Day

NOTE: The 2 afternoons will equal 1 make up day.

- Friday, March $15^{\text {th }}$, Teacher Workshop Day becomes a Student Day NOTE: The teachers have 7 workshop days so this change to student day means a teacher workshop day will be added to the end of the school year after students have been dismissed for the year. That date will be determined once we are through the winter storm season.

Also, the plan at this time is that the snowstorm on Monday, December 4th will be made up on Monday, June $10^{\text {th }}$. The Thursday, December $21^{\text {st }}$ closure will be made up on Tuesday, June $11^{\text {th }}$.

Any further weather related days will be remote days if possible. These plans could change depending on what Mother Nature throws our way in the next several months.

Please review and let me know if you have any questions or other suggestions for making up the missed school days. I will be happy to consider alternatives if needed. I look forward to finalizing these plans so we can communicate the make-up dates to families and staff.
