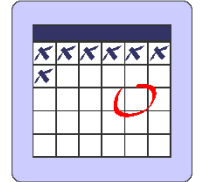

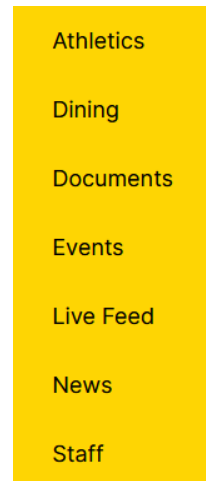
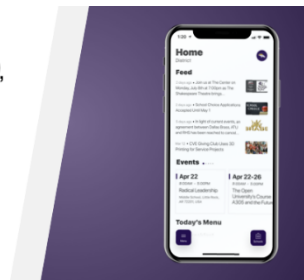

Dear Baseball and Softball Parents,

As we begin registration and planning for the upcoming season, we wanted to remind everyone of concession stand volunteer opportunities. Not only is this a great way to give back to our players and program, it is crucial to be able to have the stand operate. There are many costs that go into a full season that go beyond what our registration costs can cover. Field prep, umpire payments, monthly trash fees, new equipment, and general upkeep of the school's concession stand for allowing us to utilize it are to name a few.

Over the past few years, we have struggled to fill spots so we ask that as you complete this registration form, keep in mind that you will be expected to volunteer at least one time during the season. The stand requires someone to grill, handle cash, and food prep. Grilling must be done by an adult and an adult must be present in the stand to supervise cash handling, but community service hours can be earned by your student, 8th grade and up. We will have an OAA member open the stand each night that can quickly answer any questions you have or you could stop another night to get a feel for how it goes. We grill hotdogs and burgers, serve pretzels, nachos, in addition to candy and drinks. During cleanup there will be a handful of dishes as well as general cleanup and bathroom cleanup before locking the stand.

We understand that many families have children playing each night of the week and it can be difficult to dedicate a night to help, but please know that without additional support there may be nights that we won't be able to open which ultimately leads to lost revenue that will drive future registration costs up. We also love to be able to offer great food to our players, families, and visiting teams. We've been told we have one of the best stands around!!

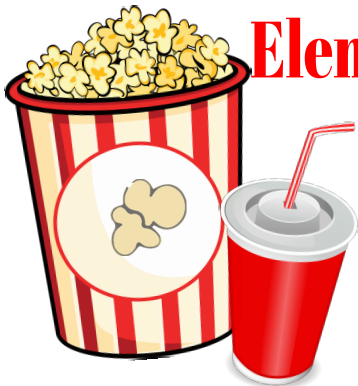
