




Well, March sure is going out like a lion! As I'm sitting here, it's blustery and cold, and very, very windy. I won't complain about the rain, since we needed it,

The baseball and softball teams got a little spoiled with the early warm weather (as we all did), but had to cancel or reschedule some of their games the first two weeks of the season.


