We are so proud of them!

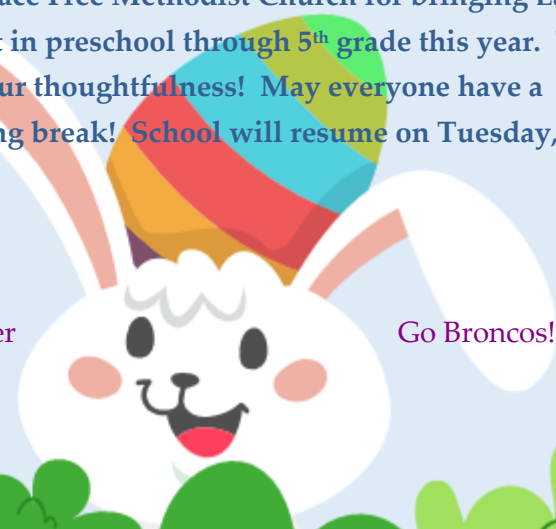

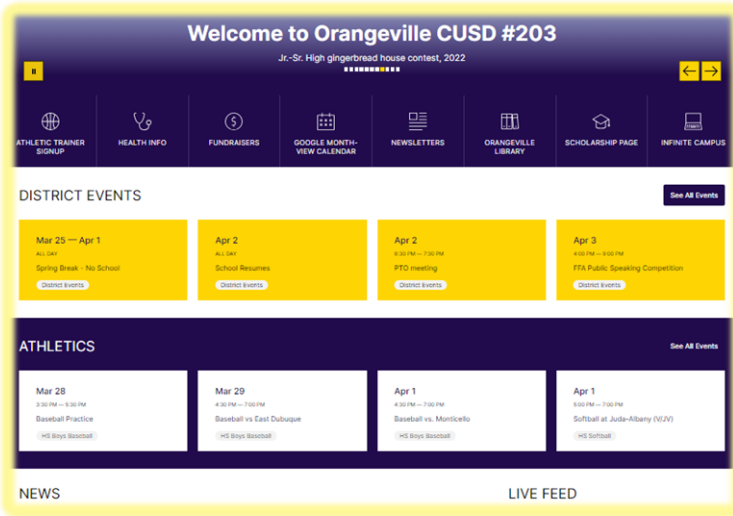




Hello “peeps”! ☺

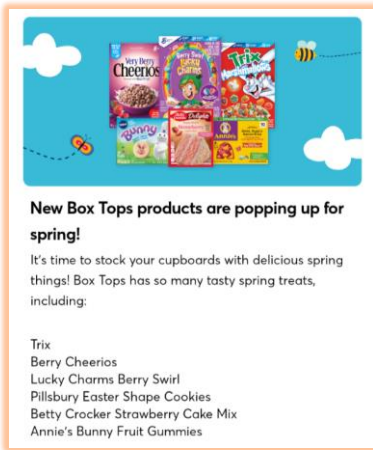
The baseball and softball teams got a little spoiled with the early warm weather (as we all did), but had to cancel or reschedule some of their games the first two weeks of the season.



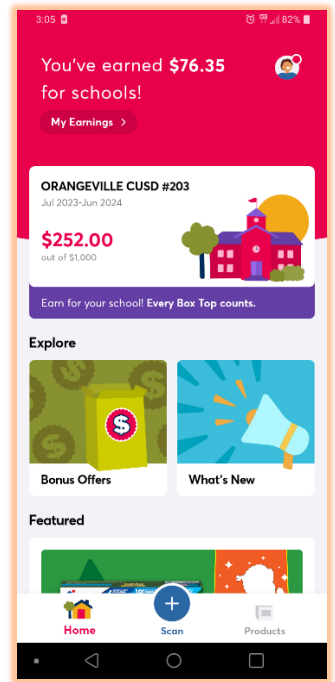

-We welcome Laura Heath as a director, thank you Laura for joining us.

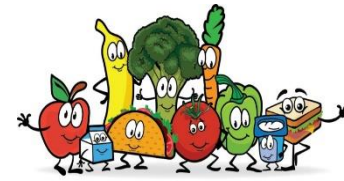
-We will begin planning the golf outing in April. The outing will be July 20th at The Ville Golf Course. Details to follow.





-Our next meeting is April 9th at 6:30pm in Mrs. MacKenzie's classroom at the high school.
