

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND COORDINATION

Policy

The district shall be responsible for establishing a district-wide curriculum by either developing the curriculum, or assisting schools to develop it. The district curriculum shall be coordinated to allow students to meet or exceed standards established by the Vermont State Board of Education.¹ Curriculum plans shall be PreK-12 within the district and will be periodically reviewed.

The superintendent shall be responsible for assisting the schools in the development, implementation, coordination, and evaluation of the curriculum.²

The superintendent shall conduct systematic evaluations of all programs within the curriculum and report the results to the school board at least annually.
