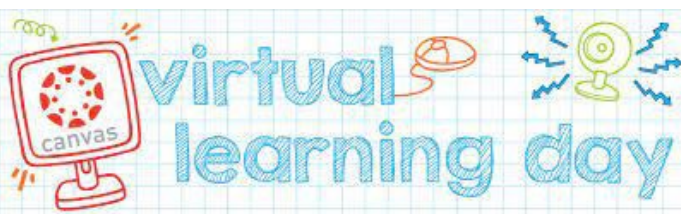

- We appreciate your help in making sure all students get home in a safe and timely manner!

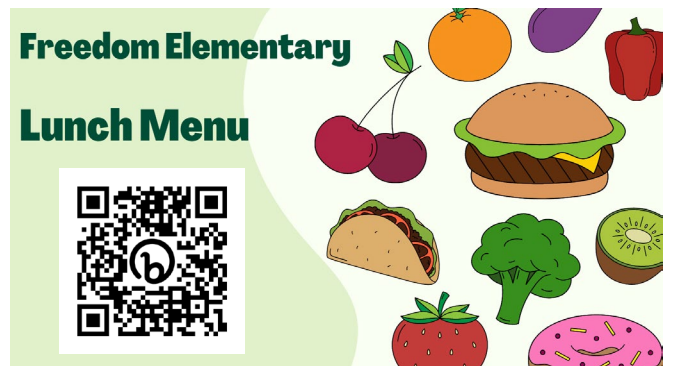


Grade Level Weekly Skills:
