LEARNING OBJECTIVES/GOALS

ELA/Reading: Scholars will learn more about informational texts by analyzing author's purpose.

Words of the Week:

- Spelling for the Week (Open and Closed Syllables): apex, vital, rotate, musical, solar, slogan, malice, recommend, energetic, register, lavish, topical, honest, element, minimum
 - Please note that we will be increasing spelling words from 10 to 15 beginning this week!
 - *Challenge Spelling: hypnotizing, epidemic, equinox

Writing: Scholars can use elements of informational writing to write an informational article.
