LEARNING OBJECTIVES/GOALS

Words of the Week:

- Spelling for the Week (Words with Final Stable Syllable -le, -tion, -sion):** article, scuffle, observation, occupation, invasion, collision, untangle, ripple, extend, assemble, declaration, particle, situation, invade, extension
