

Important Updates for AP Students

AP Exams Begin on Monday, May 6th

Room assignments: AP Test will take place in the North Library. Please check the room assignment daily with your AP teacher the day before the test.

Morning AP Exams:

- For students taking a morning exam, please report to the testing room **at 7:30am.**
- Please be sure to eat prior to the exam as no food will be permitted in the testing room.
- If you miss your assigned Lunch period due to an exam, then you will be given the opportunity to eat in the next available lunch period (2nd lunch).
- Cell Phones will **not be** permitted in the testing room.

Afternoon AP Exams:

- If you have an afternoon AP Exam, please plan on arriving to the testing room **at 11:30AM**
- If you miss your assigned Lunch period due to an exam, then you will be given the opportunity to eat in the available lunch period prior to testing (1st Lunch)
- Cell Phones will **not be** permitted in the testing room.

AP Testing Terms and Conditions:

Students taking the AP exam will sign the *Terms and Conditions* on the day of the exam. You can access these Terms and Conditions online here:

Payment:

- This 2023-2024 school year, the district will be paying for the AP Exam.

Reminders:

- Students taking two AP Exam in one day should bring their own lunch, since they will not have enough time to attend a lunch period.
- Students are expected to bring two #2 pencils, a pen with black or blue ink, and school ID.
- Cell Phones will **not be** permitted in the testing room.
- Backpack will **not be** permitted in the testing room.
- Students are to ensure their calculator is complaint with testing standards: You can access the Approved calculators online here: [Approved Calculators](https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/exam-administration-ordering-scores/administering-exams/on-exam-day/calculator-policy)

- Students are expected to bring up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities if taking an AP **Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Physics,** or **Statistics** Exam. Instruct students to visit apstudents.org/courses and click on the link for their course for the specific calculator policy.

- Students are expected to bring a ruler or straightedge if taking an AP **Physics** Exam.
- For **Digital Testing**, students must bring a Testing Device with sufficient charge to enable you to complete the AP Exam.
- Students are required to **stay for the entire duration of the exam**. No student will be excused from testing due to a conflict of any kind, including athletics. Students are expected to plan accordingly.
- If a student posts to any form of social media during the exam, or refers to unreleased exam content at any time after the exam, the student's score will be canceled, no retest will be permitted, and the student may be permanently banned from future testing
- Seniors will be able to send their AP test scores for free to their college of enrollment. There is a June 20th deadline for this submission. Students are to sign into My AP to indicate which college or university they'd like to receive their free score report.
