What you need to know!

What is Title IX?

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits any institution who gets money from the federal government (like a school) from discriminating against anyone on the basis of their gender or sex.

Under Title IX, students have two main protections:

- Equal opportunities in the classroom and in extracurricular activities
- Protection against sexual harassment

As a student at OTPS, you have the right to make a report if someone does or says something that is inappropriate or that makes You uncomfortable!

SPEAK UP!

If ANYONE in the school environment is making you uncomfortable or is being inappropriate, tell an adult you trust!

You can tell a teacher, a coach, a principal or counselor.
