Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase for Lebanon CUSD 9

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Lebanon CUSD 9 for 2024 will be held on December 18, 2025 at 6:00pm in the Lebanon Elementary School Library-408 Mary Jane Street, Lebanon, IL, 62254.

Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may contact Dr. Matt Noyes, Superintendent, at 200 West Schuetz Street, Lebanon, Illinois or (618) 537-4611.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$5,638,872.

The proposed corporate and special purposed property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$6,322,800. This represents a 12.13% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt services and public building commission leases for 2024 were \$1,089,126.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt services and public building commission for 2025 are \$1,098,691. This represents a 0.88% increase over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$6,727,998.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$7,421,491.

This represents a 10.31% increase over the previous year.
