## Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase for Lebanon CUSD 9

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Lebanon CUSD 9 for 2024 will be held on December 18, 2025 at 6:00pm in the Lebanon Elementary School Library-408 Mary Jane Street, Lebanon, IL, 62254.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$5,638,872.

The proposed corporate and special purposed property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$6,322,800. This represents a 12.13% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt services and public building commission leases for 2024 were \$1,089,126.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt services and public building commission for 2025 are \$1,098,691. This represents a 0.88% increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$6,727,998.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$7,421,491.

This represents a 10.31% increase over the previous year.
