PURPOSE

In honor of recognizing forensic science and death investigation, our office is offering a scholarship of \$1000 to one Newberry County citizen who is graduating the current year and will be going into a forensic science program. This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who has shown perseverance, compassion, and awareness for others as well as current interests in the forensic field. It is our mission to empower the youth and lead them toward professional lives. This scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to a graduating member who has enrolled in a college majoring in forensic science and who has maintained a 2.5 or better GPA. This individual must intend to continue his or her education and commitment to obtain an undergrad in forensic science.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing a Newberry County high school diploma with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 5.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted into a full-time student at a college OR university program
 for the upcoming academic semester enrolling in a forensic science program. If the
 scholarship money is awarded this is the only program that will receive funds on behalf
 of the applicant.
- STUDENT MUST LIVE IN NEWBERRY COUNTY

Scholarship applicants must provide:

- Completed application form
- Official high school transcript with GPA listed
- A minimum of 500-word essay about why you are interested in forensics and what your future plans are for your forensics background.
- Two academic references
 - o from an advisor teacher or guidance counselor
 - o from a respected adult or community member
