eLEARNING INFORMATION

In the event of a short-term disruption (either inclement weather or utilities interruption), the District will provide instruction via eLearning in one of two ways:

- On the day of the interruption, i.e. snow, ice, rain and/or wind, water line break, etc., if circumstances allow for eLearning to take place
 - OR -
- If school is not possible on the day of the interruption due to emergency circumstances, i.e. hurricane evacuation, community wide power outage, etc., the District will use one of the designated make-up days in eLearning mode (refer to District Calendar for dates)

The following guidelines will be in place:

- → Once the decision to cancel school occurs at the District level,
 District employees and parents will be notified via an automated
 phone message and social media posts.
- → Teachers will create an asynchronous eLearning lesson and post it with coordinating assignments in Schoology.
- → Students will have a five-school-day window of time to turn eLearning day assignments in (will count as an absence if not turned in).
- Consideration will be given to flexibility and understanding for all students to ensure that they continue to grow academically, socially, and emotionally.
