The ESC has secured grant funding to offer a driver's education program at a significant savings for parents/students in financial need. The program – which will include both driver's ed classroom instruction AND on-the-road instruction – will only cost the parent/student \$25.

To qualify for this program, students must meet the following:

- Qualify/receive free or reduced lunch
- No more than 2 unexcused absences during the first semester
- Recommendations from 2 school employees
- Agree to participate in all classes during selected session
- Students must be 16, 17 or 18 or must be 15 but turning 16 prior to session
- Students are not required to have a permit to begin classes, but are expected to have a plan to acquire it prior to completing the classroom instruction.

Session 1: Classes will meet January 8-11 & 15-18 from 5:30-8:30pm at the ESC in Urbana

Session 2: Classes will meet February 26-29 & March 4-7 from 5:30-8:30pm at ESC in Urbana

Students will only participate in Session 1 OR Session 2 – not both. Road driving instruction will be scheduled after the completion of classroom instruction and participants must have a driving permit to begin road driving instruction.
