Weather-related delays and closings are always possible at this time of the year. In the event of a delay or closing, exams will still be given in the same order (1st, 3rd, 7th, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th). If necessary, make-up exam time will become a scheduled exam time. If we cancel school on Friday, January 5th or Monday, January 8th, exams will still take place starting Tuesday, 1/9.

If a student has 1st block study hall, then they do not need to be at school for the first exam block or the first homeroom time. If a student has 7th period study hall, then they can sign out in the office and leave after the 3rd period exam block on Tuesday. For Wednesday & Thursday, students can leave after the 4th/6th period exam or students can choose to eat lunch during first lunch block on Wednesday and/or Thursday and then leave after lunch. We are organizing both on-campus and off-campus community service opportunities for students for the afternoon of Thursday, January 11th.

The exam schedule has a built-in 55-minute homeroom/study time each morning. Students will spend this time in their homeroom. Teachers can use this time to meet with students or to make-up missing quizzes or tests.

If a student is at school during a homeroom time – then they need to be in homeroom.

Students only sign-out at the end of a period – not part-way thru an exam block.

Students can sign in late or sign out early depending on their schedules – but NO STUDENT CAN SIGN OUT TO LEAVE AND THEN RETURN LATER FOR THEIR 7th Pd EXAM.

It is the student/family's responsibility to provide alternate transportation if the student is not riding the bus. Students riding home on the bus will report to study hall during Make-Up Exam time. Important guidelines:

- 1. Bus transportation will be provided as regularly scheduled and will not be altered for exams.
- 2. All students must remain in the classroom until the examination period is concluded.
- 3. ALL STUDENTS MUST ENTER AND EXIT THE FRONT DOORS ONLY! ALL STUDENTS MUST SIGN IN AND OUT WITH MRS. WILCOXON. AFTER SIGNING OUT, STUDENTS MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE BUILDING.
- 4. No student will be permitted access to lockers during examination periods.
- 5. Once students arrive at school for their first exam, they are not permitted to leave until they have completed their last exam of the day. STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO LEAVE SCHOOL BETWEEN EXAMS.
