

**SCHOOL BOARD MEETING MINUTES**  
**Tuesday, January 23, 2024**

**I. ROLL CALL & CALL TO ORDER**

A regular meeting of the Fairmont Area Schools Board of Education was held on Tuesday, January 23 at 5:15 p.m. in the Wm. Budd Board Room. Members in attendance were Nicole Green, Julie Laue, Mari Myren, and Jen Harris. Absent: Mike Edman and Dan Brookens. Student school board members Grace Simpson and Abi Peyman were also present.

**A. School Resource Officer Update**

Police Officer, Shannon Bass, shared details about his responsibilities as the District's School Resource Officer (SRO). Officer Bass has served on the police force for 26 years and as a SRO since 2019. The majority of his time is spent at the high school, but he also enjoys spending time at the elementary. First and foremost, Officer Bass' goal has been to help students see him as a resource and a real person, not just someone in a uniform. Officer Bass found the SRO position to be intimidating initially, but now views students and the buildings as his community. He's welcomed by students each day and believes their fear connotation related to his uniform is gone. Officer Bass stressed that his role is not to discipline, but to keep students and staff safe. In closing, he noted that the Adopt-A-Cop Program in first grade is still underway and is also an effective means for police officers to instill trust in students rather than fear.
