FAFSA stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid. FAFSA completion is state of Illinois graduation requirement. This is also how you receive money for college!

What to expect on Senior Night:

- Assistance with FAFSA completion
- Assistance with FAFSA waiver if necessary
- Support with Foundation Scholarship Application
- Local college admissions representatives available to answer questions & assist with application information

How to prepare:

- Each student & guardian must create a FSA ID at least 48 hours prior to January 8th. Visit studentaid.gov to create your FSA ID.
- Bring your log-in information and your 2024 tax return information for both the student and the guardian
