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LEE COUNTY SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP

Funds will be paid directly to the institution upon written instructions from the student.

ELIGIBILITY

The student must be:

- A resident of Lee County
- An upcoming High School Graduate planning to attending an accredited College or University
- Enrolling in agriculture, environmental science; or a related Natural Resource field
- A full-time student who is carrying at least 12 credit hours

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The applicant should be maintaining a Grade Point Average of 3.0 (on a point scale of 4.0)
- The student must submit a copy of their latest transcript High School
- If the student drops out of school, or changes to a major outside of the Soil and/or Water Conservation or Natural Resources fields, the full amount of the scholarship must be refunded to the Lee County SWCD.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

A committee selected by the Lee County SWCD Board will screen all applications. The committee's decision will be based solely upon the student's achievement without regard to the student's race, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, marital status, or handicap.
