Attention Reagan Middle School Families – 2nd SAEBRS Screening 1/29-2/16

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that we will be completing our second SAEBRS screening window at the end of this month.

The **FastBridge Social, Academic, and Emotional Risk Screener (SAEBRS)** is a 19-item assessment of students social, emotional and academic behaviors. This short survey will be completed by each classroom teacher.

MySAEBRS is the Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Risk Screener. It is an evidence-based assessment that allows students to self-assess their social, academic, and emotional behavior competencies. Students complete the self-assessment by rating the frequency of their behaviors in the previous month using a rating scale of “Never”, “Sometimes”, “Often” and “Almost Always”.

WHO
SAEBRS - All students grades K-12 MySAEBRS - Students grades 2-12
WHERE
SAEBRS -Teachers will be completing the student rating scales individually for each student in their room. Teachers will be provided with time to collaborate with students spending time with multiple teachers across their school day.
MySAEBRS - Students will complete the mySAEBERS risk screener within their classrooms on individual devices. The mySAEBRS questions are found on page 2 of this document.
WHEN
This is the second screening window of the 23-24 school year. Screening will begin the week of January 29, 2024.
WHY
SAEBRS and mySAEBRS data is useful to educators for overall program evaluation in classrooms and determining how each student can be best supported for academic success. This data will be used to determine what supports need to be in place for students through our Second Step social emotional curriculum. The data can be reviewed at parent teacher conferences.

- If you opted your student out of the initial screener, that list has been maintained and they will be opted out of the second screening as well. If you would like to opt your child back in, please contact your school office.
- If you would like to have your child opt out of participating in the second round of mySAEBRS self-assessment, please contact the office at your child’s school or email your child’s principal no later than January 26th.

Teachers will begin administration of the mySAEBRS during the week of January 29th.
