FAFSA by Appointment

A rep. from WVHEPC will meet with seniors & their families to complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA on 1/16/24 from 2-7 pm. Other FAFSA workshops will be held on 1/30/24 from 5-7 pm and on 2/13/24 from 6-8 pm. All workshops will take place in the RHS library. See Mrs. Gerstell ASAP for an appointment for one of these sessions. The new FAFSA must be completed to receive monies for technical or 2-4 yr. college. Use a personal email on the FAFSA, since the school email will expire. A parent and their student will need to apply for separate FSA IDS at least 5 days before completing the FAFSA at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> Make sure and save the FSA ID information in a safe place.

REFERENCES

Ask someone to do a reference letter 2-3 weeks before you need it. Ask the person first if they would be a good reference for you.

The GKVSF offers over 100 state-wide scholarships. Visit: www.gkvsf.org Applications are available online only. It is recommended that students use the Internet Explorer Browser to complete the application. Please read all instructions before applying. The deadline to submit the application and all attachments is 5 pm on 2/1/24. Review the listing of available scholarships and their eligibility requirements. Many scholarships have academic requirements & economic need. Some of the scholarships are renewable, worth a total of \$8,000 (examples are the WP Black & Ruth Ann Johnson). Students may only apply to two scholarships on the listing. Only one application is needed to apply to the scholarships chosen. In addition, the following documents must be scanned and uploaded with your application.

GRADUATION SUPPLIES

FINISH STRONG

Seniors make sure to keep your grades up. Check to make sure that any missing assignments have been turned in. All work for virtual classes must be submitted by 12/17/23. The first semester ends on 12/20/23, which is the deadline for all other coursework. These grades will go on your transcript. Don't find yourself behind in credits. Finish strong with the semester! Stay strong on your studies and keep track of missing assignments on Canvas!

NURSING

If you are planning to go into Nursing, many schools require a pre-admission test (HESI or TEAS). Check your school of choice to learn about their specific admission requirements for their nursing program. Application deadlines are often earlier than expected! If you are interested in Nursing at Marshall, see Mrs. Gerstell about signing up for a virtual information session. If you are interested in the LPN program at RJTC, contact Monica at 304 372-7335 for more information about taking the required test and other admission requirements.

WV INVESTS GRANT

Are you interested in obtaining a certificate or associate degree following high school? You may be able to get your tuition for free! The WV Invests Grant is a program to help pay for 1 to 2-year programs at accredited technical or community colleges in WV. Priority is given to high demand job training such as Information Technology and Healthcare. Several bachelor programs at WVU-P offer the first two years free under this program. Check out this website for specific schools participating, offering three hundred plus programs. Students must complete the FAFSA (available sometime in December) to be eligible to receive the free aid. Apply by 4/15/24 at www.collegeforwv.com/wvinvests

WVU-P ASCEND PROGRAM

Are you planning to attend WVU-P in the fall of 2024? This program can offer textbook assistance, a monthly Kroger gift card, tuition gap waiver to help with remaining tuition (if you qualify for the Pell Grant), special registration options, and enhanced tutoring services, if needed.

Apply for the ASCEND Program if you plan to major in a STEM area, Nursing & Health Sciences, Business, Accounting or Humanities, or Fine Arts & Sciences.

2024-2025 FAFSA FORM

The FAFSA stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This form needs completed by all seniors planning any type of postsecondary training. The 2024-2025 FAFSA form is new this year and will not be available to complete until sometime in late December 2023. It is also required to receive the Promise Scholarship and other state or federal aid. The FAFSA form must be completed by 3/1/24 to receive maximum aid, including the Promise Scholarship. <u>One difference from previous years is that the parent and student</u> <u>must have obtained a FSA ID five days in advance to completing the FAFSA.</u> When completing the FAFSA, each senior will need to create a student FSA ID as well as have their parent create a separate FSA ID. If parents file a joint tax return, then only one parent needs to obtain the FSA ID. If biological parents are divorced or separated, it is the parent that has provided the most financial support over the past 12 months.

HOW TO CREATE THE FSA ID

- 1. Go to www.studentaid.gov
- 2. Click: Apply for aid using the FAFSA form.
- 3. Click: Learn about 2024-2025
- 4. Click: What can you do now?
- 5. Click: Create your studentaid.gov account
- 6. Click: Get Started
- 7. Make sure to use a personal e-mail and not your school email, since it will expire.
- 8. It is advised to enter your cell phone number, for an added way to access your information.
- 9. Be accurate about entering all information.

(Take special care to enter your social security number correctly). 10. Graduation date is 5/24/24.

- 11. Keep usernames and passwords for the FSA IDS in a secure place. This will be your electronic signature for government financial documents. You will need these signatures each year you attend college or technical school.
- 12. Remember you and your parent must have your FSA ID 5 days before completing the <u>2024-2025</u> FAFSA in late December.
