

## **SENIOR TIPS**

- **cfwv.com**
  - a website full of information on post high school job trainings and education opportunities in WV
  - Promise Scholarship Information can be found at cfwv
  - has an interest inventory if students need help choosing their career path (cfwv - career planning – learn about yourself)
- **collegeforwv.com** is a WV financial aid site.
- The 2024-25 **FAFSA** will be available in December – complete it as soon as possible. Call 1 800 433 3243 if you need assistance.
  - **FSA ID** is required to be created 3-5 business days before the FAFSA is completed. You can do this now at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov)
  - **BE SURE TO STAY ON .gov sites** – other sites may charge you
- ACT/SAT/College application **fee waivers** are available in the counseling office for seniors who qualify for the free/reduced lunch program. Parents need to reapply for this each year. The application is on the county website.
- Any **scholarship** information that comes through the Ripley High School Counseling office will be listed on the Senior Newsletter and/or emailed to Seniors.
- **Senior Newsletters** are emailed the first of each month and will be on the school website. There is information for everyone on here – read through it to find what pertains to you.
- **College Applications** are online. Once the application is submitted, seniors will go to their **parchment** account and order their transcript to be sent to that school.
- Student **Athletes** – register with NCAA or NAIA
- Bring a copy of any **scholarships received** to Mrs. Holley in order to be recognized at Formal Awards in May.
- Check **college websites for deadlines**, admission requirements, etc.
