  - o **FSA ID** is required to be created 3-5 business days before the FAFSA is completed. You can do this now at studentaid.gov
  - o BE SURE TO STAY ON .gov sites other sites may charge you
- ACT/SAT/College application fee waivers are available in the counseling office for seniors who qualify for the free/reduced lunch program. Parents need to reapply for this each year. The application is on the county website.
- Any scholarship information that comes through the Ripley High School Counseling office will be listed on the Senior Newsletter and/or emailed to Seniors.
- Senior Newsletters are emailed the first of each month and will be on the school website. There is information for everyone on here read through it to find what pertains to you.
