Dress Requirements for Boys

1. Dark colored or khaki pants (NO JEANS)
2. Dress shirt with collar
3. Dark tie or bow tie– if you do not have a tie, please see Mrs. Sayre, Mrs. Holley, or one of the administrators during one of the practices.
4. Dress shoes with socks (No tennis shoes, flip flops, or work boots) If you do not have dress shoes, please see Mrs. Sayre, Mrs. Holley or one of the administrators prior to or during one of the practices.

Dress Requirements for Girls

1. Wear only dresses or dress pants that meet dress code specifications.
2. Sensible dress shoes – any color – no flip flops or tennis shoes. Open-toed shoes are acceptable.
4. Gowns need to be longer than the dresses.

If you wear inappropriate attire or don't wear a tie, you will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony. Please let Mrs. Sayre, Mrs. Holley or the administration know in advance if you need a tie, proper shoes, dress pants or a dress shirt for any of the ceremonies. You will not be permitted to walk unless you are dressed appropriately.
