Winter I Session: January 9th to February 15th

Students attending our After School program will be provided a snack to eat in their classroom. At $3: 15 \mathrm{pm}$ they will go to the area where their program is located. The programs run from $3: 15 \mathrm{pm}-4: 15 \mathrm{pm}$. Behavior expectations are on the following page. Failure to follow the expectations can lead to removal from the After School program.

This year, the After School program runs on a first come, first serve basis. Students are recommended to hand in their forms early with their first choice and second choice clearly marked in case the first choice is not available. In the event that we have extra spaces, we may open up more classes.

If your child will be riding the bus, please be sure to indicate the stop on the permission slip.
