PURPOSE: The Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment (MCA) and Minnesota Test of Academic Skills (MTAS) are reading, mathematics, and science standards

based assessments that measure student learning of the Minnesota Academic Standards. These assessments are used to meet federal and state legislative requirements. Most students take the MCA, but students who receive special education services and meet the MTAS eligibility requirements may take the MTAS instead.

The primary purpose of the English language proficiency accountability assessments is to measure progress towards meeting the WIDA English Language

Development Standards. The WIDA English Language Development Standards represent the social, instructional, and academic language that students need to
engage with peers, educators, and their school curriculum

ACT Test results will be mailed to students within 6-8 weeks following the exam.

MCA and MTAS Individual Student Test Results will be mailed to families in Fall 2023.
