

Warroad School District 23-24 COVID Plan

Warroad Public Schools will continue our efforts to maintain the health and safety of students, educators, and other staff for the 2023-2024 school year by continuing to follow MDE, MDH, and CDC requirements. As they evaluate the data and adjust requirements, Warroad's plan will be adjusted to align.

The district shall continue efforts to keep a high standard of safety and cleanliness to ensure we are able to stay in person for the foreseeable future.

These standards currently include:

- Health Screening- All students and staff are asked to conduct a daily self-screening and stay home if necessary. This is considered a good general health practice.
- Currently, it is not required to quarantine after exposure to a positive case. Please watch for signs or symptoms and a fever. Stay home if sick.
- Reporting- Please let the Warroad School District Nurse know if you have tested positive for COVID.
- If you do test positive, please see [here](#) for MDH recommendations.

What Warroad Public Schools will **NOT** do under current expectations:

- Currently, Warroad Schools is **NOT** requiring face coverings
- Warroad Schools will **NOT** require students to have a Covid-19 vaccination to attend school.
- We do **NOT** plan on implementing any restrictions that are not **mandated** by the federal or state government.

All of the above are subject to change as MDH and the CDC change expectations.
