

# MELROSE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ACTIVITIES FEE SYSTEM

## 2023 - 2024

### Purpose

A participant fee will be charged for use of equipment and facilities supplied by the district for providing additional funding to defray the costs of the school district's student activity programs.

### 1. Fee System

- A. A fee system for activities is in effect for students at the Junior and Senior High School levels as follows:

2. Maximum Fee Per School Year is \$500 Per Family

3. Fees may be waived in cases of undue hardship. The District Activities Director and/or Principal will determine hardship in each case and process all waiver requests.

4. The fee MUST be paid prior to participation in a practice or a contest.

5. All fees are to be paid to the Activities Director, in the High School Office. Coaches will not collect fees.

6. Individuals who wish to withdraw from participation will receive a refund minus a \$10 processing fee if done before the first regular game/activity. After the first regular season game/activity, no refund of fee will be given.
