Parent-Teacher Conferences

- Parent-Teacher Conferences will take place on November 29 from 12:45pm to 2:45pm and November 30 from 12:45pm-2:45pm and 6:00pm-8:00pm.
- Conferences for students in grades 6-8 and 5th grade, PE, and Specials will be 5 minutes long.
- All conferences will be virtual and conducted via Zoom or Google Meets.
- The links to teachers Zoom or Google Meets will be made available the week of conferences.
- If your child has Mx. Leghorn for RTI, you will receive an email from them with information regarding scheduling an appointment during conferences.
- When signing on to the Zoom/Google Meets session it will be helpful to use your child's name so the teacher is aware of whose parent they are speaking to.
- Registration for conferences will be available in the Genesis Parent Portal tomorrow, Tuesday, November 14th at about 3pm and will remain open until Wednesday, November 22nd at noon.
- Once the registration is open, please log onto your Genesis Parent Portal Account:
 - Click on the conferences tab.
 - Select "Schedule conference for Fall Parent-Teacher Conference"
 - Select the dates and times you would like to meet with each teacher.
 - o It is recommended that you do NOT schedule back-to-back appointments.
 - o Please do not schedule more than one conference per child per class.
- These conferences are to discuss your child's academic progress. Please sign up for conferences for classes your children are currently taking. Please do not sign up to speak to teachers who taught them during marking period 1.
- Please join the Zoom/ Google Meet 1 minute before your appointment & wait in the waiting room.
- Students will be dismissed at 12:15 on November 29, 30, and December 1. Lunch will not be served during early dismissal days.

Attention 5th Grade Parents

- Because most 5th grade student share the same teachers for ELA, Social Studies, and Math and Science, conferences for the 5th grade core classes will be conducted in teams.
- These conferences will last 10 minutes.
- You will be able sign up for a conference with your child's Science teacher. Your child's ELA/Social Studies teacher will be meeting with you at the same time.
- If your child has any of the following teachers for English or Math, please schedule conferences with them in addition to the other teachers: Ms. Agnone, Ms. Thompson, and Ms. Araneo, and Ms. Kaye.


Drop Off/Pick-Up Procedures Reminders
