#### Unexcused Absences

- Many times, parents contact us regrading absences and wonder why they are not excused.
- The state does not recognize student most absences as excused.
- The state only recognizes the following reasons as excused absences:
  - Religious observance, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:36-14, 15, and 16.
  - Participation in observance of Veterans Day, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:36-13.2.
  - Participation in district board of election membership activities, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:36-33
  - Take Our Children to Work Day
  - College visit(s), up to three days per school year for students in grades 11 and 12.
  - Closure of a busing school district that prevents a student from having transportation to the receiving school.
- It is important to continue to inform the nurse/office if your child will be absent and why. Although it is not shown on Genesis, we do take into account the reason for students' absences if truancy is in question.
