Welcome to the VHS Program. Former students have successfully met many challenges in their independent studies across diverse and exciting disciplines. Their experiences have been positive, personally meaningful, and encouraging. If you are mindful of the expectations detailed in the contract, you will be successful as well. Take the time to reflect on all of the information in this folder, and be honest—above all with yourself—about your willingness to commit to the program.

To help you out, here are some suggestions inspired by the most successful students:

- Once you have your username, log in to the VHS site; you can reach the quick link via my *Google Classroom*: 6ffeem7. Look through the materials and presentations. Do orientations in advance. Be proactive.
- Treat your VHS course as a regularly scheduled class—because it *is*. In my experience, students who logged in "every now and then" have failed or done poorly in their classes. You must be engaged with the course *every* day. If you think of it as a class you have to attend with assignments to complete, you will be fine. I have seen that simple commitment work well for many students.
- Deadlines matter. Communication with your instructor does as well. I will defer to that person, supporting his or her expectations. If you plan to do nothing and then expect "to make up" or "receive extra credit" work, then this is probably not for you. I have seen instructors provide make-up work under extenuating circumstances, but this is rather rare, for they require the appropriate justification. Most of the time, students who do not meet expectations do so for the entirety of the course, and they face the consequences. Remember this: all instructors, regardless of style, philosophy, or school, must abide by VHS grading policies (they are in your folder).
- Be mindful of academic integrity. VHS knows how and when you complete
 assignments, especially since the entire program relies on their computer platforms,
 and they are thoroughly monitored. Metuchen High School has a policy as well. Be
 smart.
- Email me during school hours with any pertinent questions or concerns. Look through your folder carefully first. Read the contract three times. Return it to me as soon as you have it; you may place it in my mailbox.
