Pool play will be two sets to 25 (no cap) with a 40 minute time limit:

8:00 – Begin matches for first round of pool play. Play will continue using time listed.
Teams assigned to the next match must be available. Warm-up may be provided prior to a team's first match of the day. After these first round matches, officials and coaches may discuss any warm-up keeping in mind the schedule.

10:20 – fourth round of pool play
11:00 – fifth round of pool play
11:40 – sixth round of pool play

Split but score the most points=2 points
Split but score the same number of points=1.5 points
Split but score fewer points=1 point.

Fewest points given up in pool play (common opponents)

Ties will be broken as follows:

A. Most points scored in pool play
(common opponents)
B. Flip of the coin
