Principal Maher gave a shout-outs to the very strong Aimsweb Testing team, Renee Saxon, Kiera Porter, Meggan Leach, Vicki Bates, Amanda Bradley, Tara Lane, and Jordan Wilson. The team was able to get the testing done within 4 days! Ed Excellence will be at OES on September 26-27 to work with teachers to answer questions and provide support. OES Open House was hold on September 12 with over 200 parents and students attending. Volleyball Fan Night on September 21 was a huge hit. Students, Teachers and Charger met at OJHS on October 4 and paraded to OES. Prizes, from stickers to a scooter, were given to every student that participated. Upcoming events include School Custodian Appreciation Day on October 2, hand-washing presentation, October 2 – October 4, Picture Day on October 10, and Curriculum Day on October 23.

6.3 OJSHS Report - Principal Kivett

Interim Superintendent McGrath presented for Principal Kivett on Homecoming Events, OJHS Girls; Volleyball (OSAA #4), OHS and OJHS Football and Cross Country. Each class decorated a section of the hallways at OJHS with movie-themed décor as part of the Homecoming events. Principal Kivett is working on increasing and improving communication with students, staff, and the community, gathering input from students, using Instagram, W@G emails, Google Chat, and surveys and developing a new Student Handbook. Outreach to the Community through Instagram and Facebook, a new Google Business profile, Coffee with the Principal, and a new and improved OJSH newsletter. New hires at OJHS include Rex Ricks – Science and Nicholas Barstad – OJH Head Basketball Coach. Upcoming Professional Development through Ed Excellence, Curriculum Leaders meeting and OWLs (teacher observations). OJSH has installed new Promethean Boards in every classroom and a shout-out to Tony Hammock for getting the boards up in the classroom under a very short time period. The District ordered 350 new Chromebooks that are currently being checked in for student usage.
