VOTING METHOD

All action taken, or motions passed or denied, shall be recorded as passed (motion carried) or denied (motion failed). A roll call vote may be requested by any member, in which event the chair shall call the roll and the ayes and nays shall be recorded.

No action of the Board shall be valid unless such action shall receive the approval of a majority of the members elected to the Board.

Board members must be present in person, via phone, or video conference to take part in all discussions concerning an agenda item and hear all comments by all board members. Board members must be permitted to hear any comments or discussion of the Board member not present. All members will have access to comments made by those permitted to speak on an agenda item or during public comment...

It is the right and duty of every member of the Board to vote.

If a member announces a conflict of interest with regard to the issue before the Board, the member may leave the meeting until voting on the issue is concluded. The conflict will be noted in the official minutes of the meeting and the roll call vote required.
