


11th ANNUAL BVMS ICE FISHING FESTIVAL + CHILI COOKOFF!

Thank you for your interest in either continuing or beginning your child's education in the Buena Vista School District.

We consider it a privilege to be part of the educational journey of each of our students. When students attend our school district who live beyond our district boundaries, it is a particular honor as we know you have a choice of where your child is educated and it takes another level of commitment to engage and attend over a distance. We receive your commitment with much respect and return your investment with our commitment to excellence for your child.

As we plan together for the 2024-25 school year, it is important for us to know desired enrollment from outside our district. While our middle and high school have capacity, our preschool, elementary, and some of our programs are nearing or at capacity. An application to enroll must be completed by March 1 to be considered for enrollment for the upcoming school year. Students currently enrolled in BV Schools from out of district will be prioritized.
