Student Wellness Funds and DPIA Funding**

1. Mental Health Counselor Cost \$105,000

Partner – Community Health and Wellness Partners

Objective – To provide mental health and crisis counseling to student body five days a week.

Students Served – Available to all 600, regular case load about 100.
2. SRO Cost \$50,000

Partner – Logan County Sheriff

Objective – To provide school security for staff and students. Education on being drug free, date violence, sexting, community policing, etc.

Students Served – 600
3. SRO Back-Up Stipend Cost \$4,000

Partner – Logan County Sheriff

Objective – Retired police officer is our back-up for the SRO when he is teaching or needs assistance with a security situation.

Students Served – 600
4. Student Mental Health Activity/Club Cost \$4,000

Partner – SoZo Center and Mary Rutan Hospital

Objective – Student-led S.O.S is a mental health and suicide prevention support club. The goal is to promote positive student culture and well-being.

Students Served – 600
5. Discovery Riders Cost \$4,000

Partner – Discovery Riders

Objective – Therapy through horse-riding provides students with anxiety, social, and emotional issues. Goal is to build confidence and social awareness in students.

Students Served – 6 to 20 per school year

6. Driver Education Courses & Driving Instruction Cost \$22,500

Partners – Master & Sylvania Driving and Schwartz Driving Schools

Objective – Provide students the opportunity to get a driver's license to build confidence and enrollment in work-based learning opportunities. Work-based learning helps students with time management, professional/soft skills, overcome anxiety and build workforce confidence. The leading barrier to attaining these helpful traits is transportation.

Students Served – 30-50 per school year

7. Free Lunch Cost \$143,000

Partner – OHP Cafeteria

Objective – We know inflation has hurt many families. Our data during the pandemic showed students did not eat breakfast as often, but they did lunch. We will provide all students with meals free of charge to provide them with the adequate energy to perform academically.

Students Served – Available to all 600 students. 35% qualify for the federal free/reduced lunch program. About 75% of the remaining 400 students will likely use the service according to pandemic data.

8. Breakfast Support Cost \$10,000

Partner – OHP Cafeteria

Objective – Support students who need breakfast that are not part of the free breakfast program.

Students Served – 5-20 per school day

9. Speaker Series Cost \$7,000

Partner – Outside Vendors

Objective – Provide speaker series to students on issues facing them, such as vaping, sexting, violence, drug & alcohol, signs of depression, suicide prevention, computer safety, etc.

Students Served – 600

10. Positive Behavior Intervention Support

Cost \$10,000

Partner – SST6, Community Business Partners



Objective – Deployment of our PBIS process and positive rewards program.

Students Served – 600




