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SUMMER SCHOOL

The Lake Forest School District may offer a Summer School program which provides opportunities for remedial instruction at the elementary level, make-up courses at the secondary level, appropriate acceleration opportunities, and special programs funded by the State and/or Federal grants.

Services of the Summer School program may be offered to students of the District whose need has been identified by teachers or the Building Administration. Students attending Summer School for the purpose of meeting District promotion guidelines or acceleration opportunities should be charged a Summer School tuition set annually by the Curriculum Department.

The Chief Academic Officer will oversee the District's Summer School program as approved by the District. Reports on summer programs will be submitted at the conclusion of each summer session to the Chief Academic Officer.

Teachers and support personnel for Summer School will be selected first from the District staff, per the negotiated agreement. Students who enroll in Summer School will be required to attend regularly and comply with Summer School attendance guidelines.

The Summer School curriculum will be aligned with the needs of students and in accordance with District and State regulations. Remedial courses at elementary levels and make-up courses at secondary levels will provide opportunities for students to earn promotion and/or credit in areas and subjects where previous work did not meet promotion/credit standards. Transportation of students for Summer School may be provided for students at the District's discretion.
