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STUDENT TEACHING AND INTERNSHIPS

The Lake Forest Board of Education recognizes the contribution student teachers can make in schools. Therefore, the Board encourages cooperation with teacher preparation institutions, and authorizes the placement of student teachers in the Lake Forest School District.

The importance of the teacher preparation function to the future of education and assurance of effective performance in schools demands that student teachers only be placed with effective teachers.

- Teachers accepting the added responsibility of training student teachers must hold a minimum of a continuing license and have the approval of Building Administration. All placement requests shall be coordinated between the institution's placement coordinator and the Human Resources Director or designee.
- A person in a teacher preparation program must have criminal background, child protection registry and tuberculosis checks completed prior to any placement being approved per Delaware Administrative Code, <u>Title 14</u>, Section 746.
