DECEMBER NEWSLETTER

December is a magical month of learning here at Carrolls. We are moving into the second trimester and students are making huge growth based on goals they have set. This is a time where students adjust their goals and continue persevering. Their teachers help guide them in their goal-setting by ensuring goals are realistic and attainable, and support students along the way as they monitor and adjust throughout as needed. You can also support your child with their goal-setting by asking your child about their goals in class or by reaching out to their teacher. As teachers shared your child's GLOWS and GROWS at conferences, use that information to continue supporting your student on reaching proficiency at their grade-level standards. If you need ideas on how to do this, please reach out to us here at Carrolls and we can collaborate. When we return in January, we will dive into our benchmarking window for Reading and Math on iReady (K-5).

Mobile Clothing Closet~

The mobile clothing closet will be at Carrolls on Wednesday, December 13, 2023. If your child has accessed the closet before and you no longer need items, please reach out to Dr. Owens and she will remove your child from the list. Also, if your child has not yet accessed the mobile clothing closet and you are in need, reach out to Dr. Owens and she will get your child added to the list. At this time, you will be asked about your child's sizes and any specific needs he/she may have.

Attendance Matters~

Did you know that missing just 2 days a month of school can have a grave impact on your student? Not only does chronic absenteeism present academic challenges to your child, it also affects the classroom as it hampers your child's teacher's ability to engage all students in learning and being able to meet individual needs (Attendance Works, 2023). Absenteeism in the first month of school can predict poor attendance throughout the school year; poor attendance can influence whether children read at a proficient level by the end of 3rd grade; and by 6th grade, chronic absenteeism is an indicator to the likelihood of a student dropping out of high school. When your child is missing, the classroom is not complete and our school is not complete. YOU can support us in our efforts to improve attendance at Carrolls. When

attendance rates are improved, students' academics and graduation rates improve. If you have any questions about your child's attendance, please reach out to Ms. Townsend or Dr. Owens.



Annual Highly Capable Testing

All Kelso 2nd students are scheduled to take the CogAT assessment as part of the district's efforts to determine eligibility for the Highly Capable program. Each elementary school will be testing sometime in January.

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

This year, Carrolls Elementary & Kelso School District is making a special effort to ensure that all students fully benefit from their education by attending school regularly. Student attendance is an essential first step for students to learn. We want you to know that our school is committed to supporting your student(s) to attend and access their education. Your students' future is our first priority, and we want to partner with you to ensure their success.

DID YOU KNOW?

- By being present at school, your child learns valuable social skills and has the opportunity to develop meaningful relationships with other students and school staff.
- Absences can be a sign that a student is losing interest in school, struggling with schoolwork, dealing with a bully, or facing some other potentially serious difficulty.
- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences (excused and unexcused) can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10 percent (just two days a month or about 18 days in a year) increases the chance that your student will not read or master math at the same level as their peers.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks.
- By 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school.
- By 9th grade, regular and high attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores.

WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU

We miss your student(s) when they are not in school and we value their contributions to our community. We would like you to help ensure that your student attends regularly and is successful in school. What you can expect from Carrolls Elementary and Kelso SD for attendance support:

1. Student accrues 5 unexcused absences

- a. School team meeting with student, parent, counselors (other staff as needed)
 - i. Attendance agreement
 - ii. Risk/needs assessment/questionnaire
 - iii. School based solutions

2. Student accrues 7 unexcused absences

- a. Attendance and Re-engagement Program (ARP) workshop referral with Educational Service District (ESD) (virtual, every other Wed @ 4pm) for both student and parent
 - i. Review why attendance matters, how to excuse an absence and what for (school rep), Becca Bill & truancy process (probation officer). Statistics on attendance importance will be presented.
 - 1. Break out rooms with ARP case manager & school rep
 - a. Review original Risk/needs assessment/barriers questionnaire to address concerns and acknowledge progress.
 - b. Review current skyward account for accuracy
 - c. Either direct referral to board or give students one week to reengage in school. Students will be referred to community resources and progress checked within a week.

3. Student accrues 10 unexcused absences

- a. Board referral (process of creating an action plan)
 - i. Representatives from community resources
 - 1. Mental health, school rep, ARP case manager, alternative education, Family Community Resource Center, Ethnic support council, etc. (tailored for student needs
 - 2. Release of Information (ROI) signed at this level
 - ii. Complete board agreement form, address barriers, refer to services/set up intakes
 - iii. Introduce ARP case manager, follow up on services referred, board agreement, attendance expectations

4. Student does NOT follow board agreement or attendance does NOT improve

- a. Exited from ARP services (ESD Advocate will send Truancy Liaison a report to add to the petition).
- b. Court petition Kelso School District representative completes and attends court and continues to monitor student attendance

PLAN FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER

Snow, ice, and wind can impact our ability to conduct school activities as planned. Depending on the road conditions, any one of the following may happen:

1) Buses are on snow routes.

All schools and activities continue, but some routes are altered. Snow route details are on our Transportation web page.

2) School is delayed two hours.

Buses pick up students two hours later than normal; no breakfast or AM preschool.

- School is canceled for the day.
 All schools, activities, and athletics are canceled for the day.
- School is dismissed early.
 All activities and athletics are canceled.

HOW WE DECIDE

Before deciding to close schools, district officials consult county road crews and our own employees who are out driving the roads in the early hours of the morning.

Our district covers a large region with steep terrain in places. While roads may be passable in town, conditions may be different just a few miles away. Before we close schools we seek answers to the questions below:

- Can we ensure that buses can navigate streets safely?
- Will students be safe waiting for buses, driving, or walking to school?
- What are the predicted weather conditions later in the school day so we can also ensure students a safe return home?
- Will conditions be substantially improved if we start school late?
- Will we have heat and lights in our schools?

HOW WE INFORM YOU

We attempt to provide you with as much prior notice of school closures as possible. We make every effort to announce changes by 6 AM and we use a variety of methods to get the information to parents and staff.

KSD App

Download the Kelso School District app and enable notifications for the district and/or specific schools.

Remember:

No news is good news! We only make announcements when there are changes in normal routine.
