

## School Support Organizations

### Policy 4120

The board encourages the formation of a parent-teacher-student association or similar school support organizations at each school building for the purpose of providing an opportunity through which parents, teachers, and students may unite their efforts and interests to enhance the school program. In schools where no such organization exists, another parent group can be recognized by the school principal as the official body through which parents, staff, and students may unite their efforts for similar purposes.

Booster clubs and/or special interest school support organizations may be formed to support and strengthen specific activities conducted within the school or district. All such groups must receive annual approval of the school principal/designee and superintendent/designee in order to be recognized as a school support organization. Staff participation, cooperation, and support are encouraged in such recognized organizations.

Annual renewal should occur each school year by October 1. Use of school district property and facilities and the ability to provide donations, are contingent upon annual approval. All Student support groups shall comply with all necessary laws, district policies and procedures, and Procedure 4120P. The approved list of school support organizations will be shared annually with the board.
