THE ACT IS COMPOSED OF 5 TESTS: ENGLISH, MATEMATICS, READING, SCIENCE, AND WRITING.

FAFSA Launch Date - Dec. 31
Federal Student Aid (FSA) announces the 2024-25 will go live by December 31 and institutions will receive ISIRs by the end of January 2024.

### PowerSchool Mobile App

Download PowerSchool mobile from the iTunes or Google Play Store.

- Parents must first create a parent account prior to this setup.
- The first time you launch the PowerSchool Mobile App you will need to associate your account with a specific server using a District Code: RPWJ
- You will have access to your student's grades, assignments, attendance, and more.

-VISIT COLLEGES OR UNIVERSITIES AND MEET WITH ADMISSIONS AND FINANCIAL AID REPRESENTATIVES.

-FINISH AND SUBMIT YOUR FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

-COMPLETE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS AND KEEP LOOKING FOR MORE TO APPLY FOR. REVIEW THE BULLETIN BOARD IN THE SGHS HALLWAY AND THE SCHOOL WEBSITE FOR ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS.

-COMPLETE A HOUSING APPLICATION AND SEND IN A DEPOSIT TO THE COLLEGE YOU HAVE DECIDED ON.

-INFORM EVERY COLLEGE OF YOUR ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION OF THE OFFER OF ADMISSION/FINANCIAL AID

-ASK YOUR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR TO SEND A FINAL TRANSCRIPT TO YOUR COLLEGE

-REVIEW YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARDS; IT'S IMPORTANT TO CHOOSE THE AID PACKAGE THAT IS BEST FOR YOU AND YOUR FAMILY.

-SCHEDULE YOUR ORIENTATION DATES AT THE COLLEGE YOU WILL BE ATTENDING IN THE FALL.
