Student IDs

At this point, all students should have a badge or a temporary badge.

Badges should be displayed around each students neck. As far as the lanyards go, as long as they are school appropriate, students can use any lanyard of their choice. We have free ribbon students can use if they are in need of a lanyard. Students without an ID will be given a loaner ID and administration will be logging infractions.

We have been lenient on giving students loaner badges up to this point. Beginning on Monday, January 8th, ID infractions and consequences will begin for 2nd semester and we will no longer be giving students loaner badges.

ID Infractions:

There will be consequences for not adhering to the ID policy. They will be as follows:

1-3 times: students will be given a warning and a temporary ID (blank badge with name/grade handwritten on it)

4+ times: lunch detention + phone call home

as needed: ISS/suspension

Lost badges will cost \$5 to replace and the colored holder to match their grade level will cost \$2.

Tutoring

CIMS offers tutoring in a variety ways.

Each morning we have before school tutoring. Mrs. Haley, Ms. Fields, Ms. Decker, and Mrs. Harding each offer tutoring in their classrooms from 8:10-8:30 am. **This requires no prior permission and students may go when they feel they need to.**

During lunches, we have one teacher per grade level where students can go and work quietly. Students may find their grade level principal and let them know they would like to attend so they can communicate to that teacher to expect the student.

After school on Tuesdays and Thursdays, we have one teacher per grade level that can also work with students.

Parents must contact a grade level principal in order to assign their student to after school tutoring.

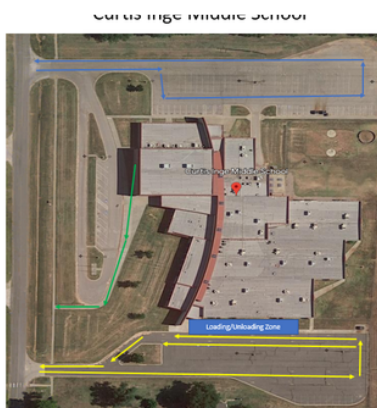
Absences Add up!

Pick-Up and Drop-Off Map

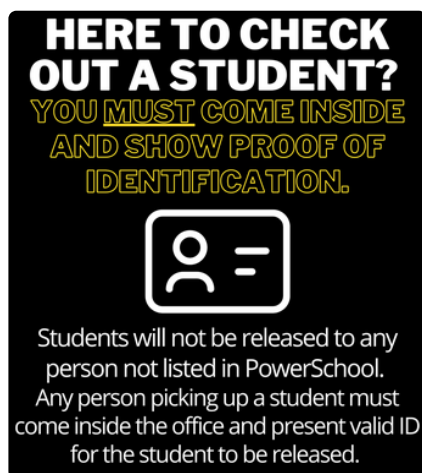
Follow this guide for a smooth morning and afternoon. Please be mindful as to not block driveways, handicap ramps, and our neighbors at The Lodge.
