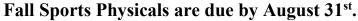

Winter Sports Physicals are due by November 1st.

Winter Sports include Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, and Cheerleading.

Spring Sports Physicals are due by March 1st.

Spring Sports include Boys Baseball, Girls Softball, and Track & Field.

Late Physicals cannot be accepted. Physical exams must have taken place no more than one (1) year prior to the dates listed above.

Please complete all of the following forms. Incomplete Sports Physical Packets must be returned and students may not be able to participate in tryouts.

- 1. Health History Form: Complete this form before your visit to the doctor. Both the parent/guardian and student need to sign this page. Bring it with you to your doctor's appointment.
- **2.** Athlete with Special Needs: Complete this form if you have a student with special needs. Otherwise, it may be left blank.
- 3. Physical Examination Form: Your child's doctor will complete this page.
- 4. Clearance Form: Your child's doctor will complete this page.
- **5. Health History Update Questionnaire:** Parent must complete and sign this page each season.

Cardiac & Injury Education: NJ law requires that athletes and parents/guardians review information on sudden cardiac death, concussion, opioid use and misuse, and eye injuries. NJ law also requires that **both** the parent/guardian and student sign the following three pages once per school year:

- 6. Sudden Cardiac Death Sign-Off Sheet
- 7. Concussion Sign-Off Sheet
- 8. Opioid Drug Sign-Off Sheet
