

# Chromebook - Connecting to a Mobile Hotspot

The following will take you through the steps needed to connect your Chromebook to a mobile hotspot.

## 1. Press and hold the power button until the hotspot turns on.

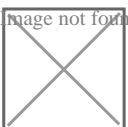
The wireless settings icon will be at the bottom right hand corner of either the login screen or your desktop as pictured below:

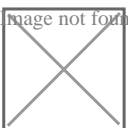
