# Auto Program

- 8:00 - 10:00 am
- At Lake Land College Campus
- Earn 12.5 credits
- Classes include Intro to Auto, Rigging and Hoisting, Careers, Intro to Auto 2
- Cost is \$500 for the student
- At school schedule will include periods 4-8
- Students must have transportation, be dependable, and have a 2.0 GPA

# Health Occ

- Morning or afternoon classes are available at Sarah Bush Lincoln Health Center in Mattoon
  - 7:30 - 9:15
  - 1:00 - 2:45
- Must provide own transportation
- Must be dependable, trustworthy, and have good attendance
- Cost is \$500
- Earn 11 credit hours from Lake Land
- Test for CNA license at end of program
- Very high demand and we only get a few spots

# CEO

- Entrepreneurship class in which students learn how to start their own business
- 7:15 - 9:00
- Meet in Arthur, Sullivan, Arcola, and Tuscola
- Can be taken for dual credit - 6 credits
  - Approx \$120
- Must provide own transportation

# Work Coop

- Early dismissal/late arrival for students with a job
- Enroll in classroom portion of class that meets consumer ed requirement (1 cr)
- Miss up to three periods of the day for work (1 cr)
- Must have good attendance and your own transportation
- Having job already is helpful but Ms. Ford can also help students find a job

# Blended Classes

- A blended class is a combination of face-to-face instruction and online learning.
- Allows teachers to work with students in a smaller setting and provide additional direct instruction to meet the needs of the individual students.
- An ideal blended learning environment, students have some control over the pace, place, and path of their coursework.
- English IV, Accounting, History of US DC, Sociology DC, Literature
- If students are earning less than a 70%, they must stay in class
