What are ESSER and ARP ESSER funds?

The Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER Fund) was established as part of the Education Stabilization Fund in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, and ARP ESSER funds were issued as part of the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act. Both funds were issued to address the impact that COVID-19 had and continues to have on education in the United States.

We believe that meaningful stakeholder consultation is important and should represent the diversity of the community within Lincoln Parish. We recognize and respect the work that our parish has done throughout the pandemic and continues to do to engage and improve our community. Stakeholder consultation is essential, and we strive to amplify best practices and engage the diverse communities that we serve.
