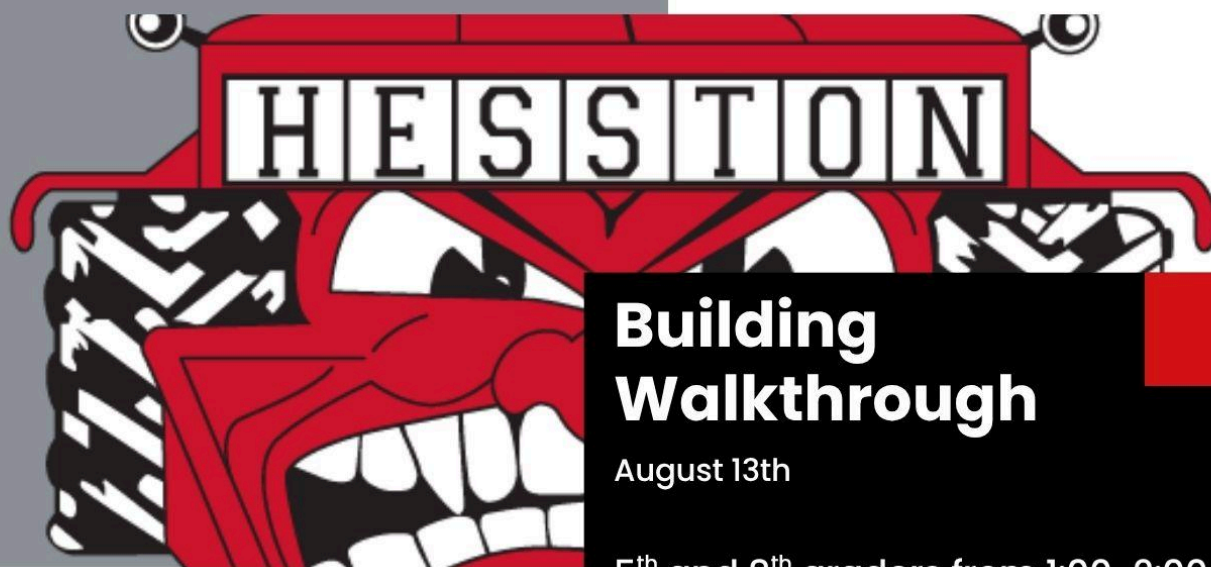

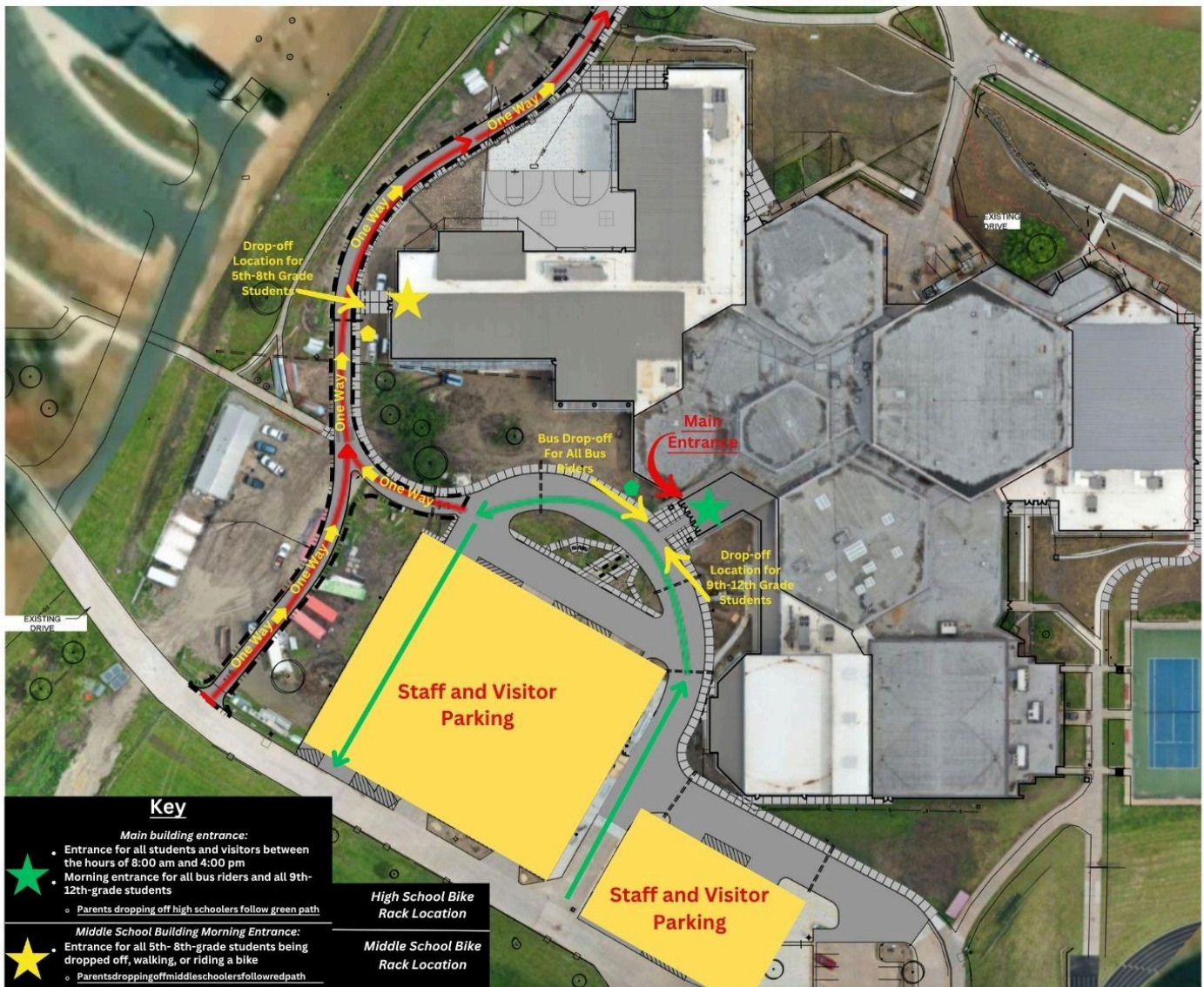

# Arrival Map



The primary entry point for middle school student will be the west end doors of the middle school academic wing marked with a yellow star on the map above. Students that are walking, biking, or getting dropped off in a car should enter that door.

Middle school students arriving on the bus, or in the same car as a high school student will enter the main entrance marked with a green star in the map above.

Doors will open at 7:40am. Breakfast will be served in the commons starting at that same time. Non breakfast students will go to the designated location for their grade level regardless of the door they entered. 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will wait in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor hallway of the middle school academic wing and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will wait in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor hallway till the 7:55am bell rings. At that time students will proceed to their RS class to start the day. At that time it is also expected that they place any personal electronic devices into their pouch and store them in their backpack. Those devices will remain put away till the end of the school day when the 3:20pm bell rings.
