This tree endeavors to help with some of the expenses of Christmas for community families in need. We invite all parents/guardians who feel they could use a little help to fill out an application listing their child/children by name and age, and provide some gift suggestions—with sizes, if clothing is listed.

Applications are available at the Hesston Public Library (HPL); Hesston Elementary, Middle, and High Schools; Hesston Police Department; and the Hesston Resource Center. All applications will need to be turned in by Friday, November 17 to the HESSTON PUBLIC LIBRARY BOOK DEPOSITORY (300 N Main St.) in a sealed envelope marked "Christmas Giving Tree." Each child's name turned in will get one tag on the tree with their age, sex and gift description--up to 4 new items totalling a suggested \$50 combined. The identification of the children will not be disclosed.

The tags will be available on the tree at the HPL as applications come in. **All gift** donations must be brought back to the Police Department (444 N Lancaster) by Friday, December 8 at noon. The gifts should be wrapped with the tag attached. The gifts will then be delivered to families, by the Hesston Police, on December 14 and 15.

We hope, by using the application process, we may serve the children who need the help of the community and not leave anyone out. It is our goal that everyone has a blessed and happy Christmas, both the giver and the receiver. We hope you will prayerfully consider participation.

Christmas Giving Tree 2023 Application

All applications must be turned in no later than Friday, November 17 to the Hesston Public Library (300 N Main St.) in a sealed envelope marked "Christmas Giving Tree."

The application envelope can be dropped in the exterior Book Depository 24/7, or given to a library employee during business hours. Each child's name turned in by November 17 will get one tag on the tree with their age, sex and gift(s) description--up to 4 new items totalling a suggested \$50 combined. The names of the children will not be on the tags. Applications will be reviewed under FERPA regulations. Gifts will be delivered December 14-15 between 8-5:00, to the address provided, unless you mark that you will pick up gifts at the Police Department (444 N Lancaster) between 8-5:00 on those two days.

Who can apply?

Parents/Guardians may register any child(ren), ages newborn-18, who either resides in the USD 460 School District, or attends a USD 460 school, and can show free or reduced-price meals approval. Copy/complete an additional form if you have more than three children.

How to apply

Return the attached form to the Hesston Public Library Book Depository, completed with each child's information and gift wishes/needs along with copies of the following item(s) in a sealed envelope labeled "Christmas Giving Tree."

1. USD 460 letter of approval for free/reduced-price meals from your food service director. Hesston's Director is Becky Mason (phone 620-327-7125 or email becky.mason@usd460.org).

If you don't have proof of free/reduced-price meals approval due to child not of school age, please provide the following:

- Proof of residence (utility or bank statement or pay stub)
 AND
- 2. Proof of need by submitting a copy of **ONE** of the following items:
 - -Proof of subsidized housing
 - -Proof of unemployment or disability
 - -Proof of food stamps or WIC
 - -Current Pay Stub
